Audition date: Sunday 19 March 2023 at the Stables Theatre, Hastings. Auditions will start at 10am.

The running of the day will be as follows: 10am till 1pm – Turings 2pm - call backs for Turings plus the rest of the cast.

Performance dates: 2 June 2023 to 10 June 2023.

Rehearsals

Tuesday and Thursday evenings 7.30 to 9.30pm. Rehearsals will start immediately in the week following the auditions. Until the later stages of rehearsal, calls will be mainly for small groups or two-handers. The evening may be split, you may only be called for the first or second half of the evening. If not called you are not required to attend. Turing will be called for every rehearsal. From the middle of May we will also rehearse on Sunday afternoons, and all the cast will be called. Rehearsals will be at, or close to, the Stables Theatre. Please state at the auditions any dates on which you would be unable to rehearse – or any other acting commitments you have during our rehearsal period. N.B. Your full availability will be required in the two weeks preceding our opening night.

Cast Required

- Playing ages given below are for guidance and are not determinative. If you wish to audition for a role but feel you are not the right playing age, please either audition in any event or contact the director prior to the audition.
- Some of the characters are based on real people Alan Turing, Sara Turing, Dilly Knox, Pat Green (based on Joan Clarke). If auditionees intend to audition for these roles, they may wish to research the characters beforehand.
- You are strongly advised to read the play before auditioning. For a £10 refundable deposit you may borrow a script from the Stables theatre.

Characters

- Alan Turing a large part playing age 13 to 41
- Mick Ross, a medium part a detective requires a Lancashire accent playing age 30-45
- Sara Turing, a medium part Turing's mother playing age 38 71

- Ron Miller, a medium part a young man having an affair with Turing requires a broad Manchurian accent playing age 20-30
- Dilly Knox, a medium part Turing's manager at <u>Bletchley Park</u> playing age 60+
- Patricia "Pat" Green, medium part a co-worker of Turing's at Bletchley playing age 24-30
- Christopher Morcom, a small part Turing's school friend playing age 13-17
- John Smith, a small part a British Secret Service agent playing age 30+
- Nikos, a small part a young Greek lover all lines in Greek (tuition recording available!)
 playing age 17+
